ACTION REQUESTED

The PARC is asked to appoint two members to serve on a subcommittee to focus on West Bridge Park improvements with the Block 52 redevelopment. The team will revisit the overall Downtown Small Area Plan along with the Walnut Corridor Improvements. Staff will gather ideas from the public at upcoming city events such as Walk & Roll and RiverFest as part of the Community Needs Assessment. The goal is for staff to develop an RFP Fall 2022.
