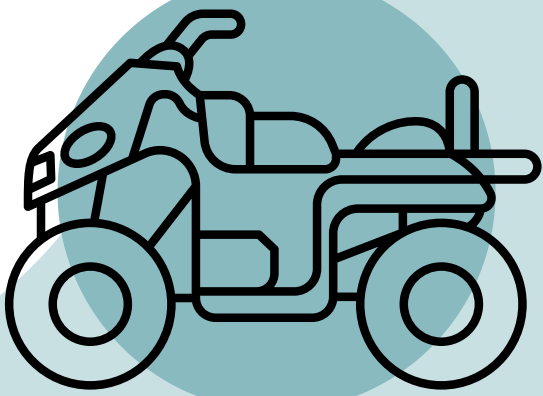


UPDATED RECREATIONAL MOTOR VEHICLE ORDINANCE

What's Included?



PERMIT NEEDED

01

CLASS 1 ATVS

A Class 1 all-terrain vehicle means it has a total width from outside of tire rim to outside of tire rim that is 50 inches or less. These are now allowed in specific locations as noted on the *City's Class 1 ATV/Golf Cart Street Map*.

02

CLASS 2 ATVS

A Class 2 all-terrain vehicle means it has a total width from outside of tire rim to outside of tire rim that is greater than 50 inches but not more than 65 inches. These operate in accordance with the state statutes, but must be permitted for use in the city limits.

03

GOLF CARTS

A self-propelled three or four-wheeled vehicle commonly used for transportation on a golf course. Limited to a total weight of less than 800 pounds. These are now allowed in specific locations as noted on the *City's Class 1 ATV/Golf Cart Street Map*.

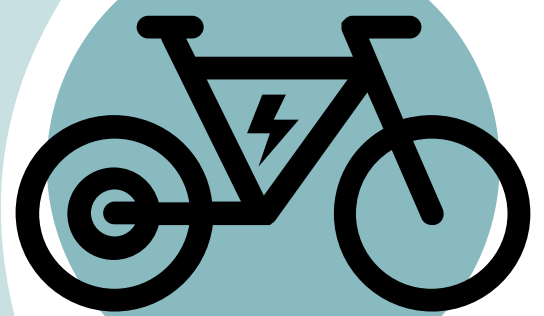


NO PERMIT NEEDED

04

ELECTRIC-ASSISTED BICYCLES

A device with two or three wheels; a saddle and fully operable pedals; and an electric motor that is 1,000 watts or less.

MOTORIZED FOOT SCOOTERS

A scooter powered by an internal combustion engine or electric motor. No more than two 12-inch or smaller diameter wheels and a maximum speed of 15 MPH.



HOW DO I APPLY FOR MY PERMIT?

- Apply for your permit at City Hall
- Bring a copy of your driver's license and insurance
- Costs \$25 and lasts for 3 years
