Compost Site Access Card Request Form

The City of Monticello will issue property owners one access card to the compost site located at 1801 River St W. This site is available, at no cost, from April to December each year for city residents only; **no contractors** will be allowed to use the site.

By signing below, you acknowledge the following:

- I live at the property stated below.
- I understand that if the access card is lost, I must notify the City immediately and payment of \$10.00 is required to obtain a new card. If I find the lost card, the City will not reimburse the replacement card since the original will have been deactivated.
- If I move, I will return the access card to the City.

Violation of any of the following will result in the loss of access to the compost site:

- I understand I cannot give out the access card for non-residents to gain access to the City's compost site.
- I understand the compost site is under 24-hour recorded surveillance. Any illegal disposing of items not listed at the site entrance will be reported to the Wright County Sheriff's Office to issue a citation.
- I understand I cannot dispose of anything other than grass and leaves at the site.
- I understand grass clippings and leaves must be removed from bags and the bags disposed of properly (there will be a trash can on-site during the spring, summer and fall months).
